

## CAREER OPTIONS

According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, **employment of radiologic technologists is expected to grow by 28 percent** from 2010 to 2020, faster than the average for all occupations. Radiologic technologists **typically need an associate's degree**. Technologists must be licensed or certified in most states; requirements vary by state.

Graduates of non-college credit educational programs often find an A.S. degree is helpful in addition to their professional credentials, particularly when interested in pursuing a career in management, education or sales.

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
