- **ENC 1101** - English Composition I (Credit Hours: 3) - **Prerequisites:** Satisfactory score on placement test (for non-exempt students only). **See program note 1*.**
- **MAC 1105** - College Algebra **or higher** (Credit Hours: 3) - **Prerequisites:** MAT 1033 with a grade of “C” or better, satisfactory score on the placement test.
- **BSC 2085C** - Human Anatomy and Physiology I (Credit Hours: 4) – **Prerequisite:** None.
- **PSY 1012** - General Psychology (Credit Hours: 3) - **Prerequisites:** Qualify for enrollment in ENC 1101.
- **CHM 1020** - Chemistry for Liberal Arts (Credit Hours: 3) (**or any college level CHM prefix course**) - **Prerequisite:** None. **See program note 3*.**
- **Choose 1 General Education Humanities** (See link below for options). **See program note 2*.**
- **BSC 2086C** - Human Anatomy and Physiology II (Credit Hours: 4) - **Prerequisites:** Completion for BSC 2085C with a grade of “C” or higher.
- **DEP 2004** - Human Growth and Development (Credit Hours: 3) - **Prerequisites:** Satisfactory score on reading and writing placement test (placement into ENC1101).
- **MCB 2010C** - Microbiology (Credit Hours: 4) - **Prerequisites:** CHM 1020 or CHM 1025C or CHM 1032C or CHM 2045C or other College level chemistry course or placement into CHM 2045C or higher by chemistry placement exam.

CAREER OPTIONS

Graduates will **qualify as entry-level registered nurses** in multi-variant settings as members of the health care profession upon passing the National Council Licensure Examination (NCLEX). Nurses can work in small or large medical groups, fly with trauma center helicopters, or travel with humanitarian or first-response teams. According to the Bureau of Labor Statistics, employment of registered nurses is **expected to grow 26 percent** from 2010 to 2020, faster than the average for all occupations. Growth will occur primarily because of technological advancements, an increased emphasis on preventative care and the large aging baby-boomer population who will demand more healthcare services as they live longer and more active lives.

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
